## **Historical Note**

The bishops of the United States made the decision to found The Catholic University of America on December 2, 1884. A month later, during the first meeting of the committee to which the bishops had delegated the work of organization, the University was named. Pope Leo XIII, who was a source of encouragement from the beginning, gave formal approbation to the project on April 10, 1887. Immediately thereafter, civil incorporation in the District of Columbia was obtained. Later in the year, the Pope named John Joseph Keane, bishop of Richmond, to be the first rector. Papal approval of the first constitution of the University was given on March 7, 1889, and the University was opened on the following November 13.

At the time, the modern American university was still in its infancy. The Johns Hopkins University in 1876 had been the first in the country to dedicate itself not only to the preservation of learning and teaching, as American institutions had been doing since the foundation of Harvard College on an English model in 1636, but also to the advancement of knowledge through research in the manner of the Prussian universities of the 19th century. Engagement in research and the training of graduate students to carry it out were to become the hallmarks of university status. By developing in this pattern, The Catholic University of America became the principal channel through which the modern university movement entered the American Catholic community. In 1900, Catholic University was among the 14 institutions offering instruction for the doctorate that formed the Association of American Universities.

Only in 1904 were undergraduate programs added to the offerings of the University, although some undergraduate instruction had been offered earlier to candidates for graduate and professional degrees. Undergraduate students now comprise more than 50% of the annual enrollment.

Today, the University includes 12 schools, all of which offer graduate and professional degrees. Ten schools — architecture and planning; arts and sciences; business; engineering; music, drama, and art; nursing; philosophy; professional studies; social service; and theology and religious studies — award undergraduate degrees. Catholic University is the only American university with ecclesiastical faculties granting canonical degrees in canon law, philosophy, and theology.

Catholic University's academic offerings are organized in accord with the official mission statement of the University approved by the Board of Trustees on December 12, 2006:

As the national university of the Catholic Church in the United States, founded and sponsored by the bishops of the country with the approval of the Holy See, The Catholic University of America is committed to being a comprehensive Catholic and American institution of higher learning, faithful to the teachings of Jesus Christ as handed on by the Church. Dedicated to advancing the dialogue between faith and reason, The Catholic University of America seeks to discover and impart the truth through excellence in teaching and research, all in service to the Church, the nation, and the world.

# Brigadier General William T. Bester, M.S.N. 1985

Doctor of Nursing, honoris causa

In his own words, the ability to rapidly gather facts and make crucial and prudent decisions is what brings our attention today to Brigadier General William T. "Bill" Bester, the 21st chief of the U.S. Army Nurse Corps and the first male officer to hold that position in the Corps' 119-year history.

To review his personal and professional record is to witness a succession of prudent decisions made by Brig. Gen. Bester, decisions that produced results crucial to the welfare of tens of thousands of military personnel, nursing students, civilian patients, and refugees he has served during a medical career spanning almost five decades.

It was at the College of St. Scholastica in Minnesota that, in order to help defray his educational expenses, Bill Bester made the decision to join the Army Student Nurse Program. That in turn led, after his graduation in 1974, to Army Medical Department basic training and his first assignment — as First Lieutenant Bester — to Madigan Army Medical Center in Washington State. In rapid sequence, he was dispatched as a clinical staff nurse to Okinawa, promoted to captain, and returned to Beaumont Army Medical Center in Texas for training in anesthesiology.

In 1979, he was selected for the U.S. humanitarian mission assisting Cuban refugees — an assignment he "really loved" and that would significantly influence his future. He was appointed chief nurse of the 10th Combat Support Hospital at Fort Meade in 1981, and soon thereafter began his studies for a master's degree in medical-surgical nursing at The Catholic University of America.

By 1990 he had risen to the rank of lieutenant colonel and, after various tours of duty in the U.S. and Europe, in 1998 was named commanding officer of the Army hospital at Fort Jackson, S.C., the first Army nurse chosen for the post. Two years later, now a brigadier general, he would become chief of the Army Nurse Corps. During his four-year tenure as chief, Gen. Bester oversaw the large-scale provision of nursing assets for Operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. He also pushed the expansion of the gender and ethnic diversity of the Corps, and for an increase in funding for military nursing research.

Following his retirement from active duty, Gen. Bester served as professor of clinical nursing at the University of Texas-Austin, as chief nurse of a civilian humanitarian team in Indonesia while aboard the USNS *Mercy*, and in a number of senior academic positions at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, Md. He remains active today as a senior advisor to the Jonas Center for Nursing and Veterans Healthcare, with a focus on the vulnerable that is especially poignant in a time of social distancing that can produce isolation.

For his long and dedicated service to the nursing profession, the U.S. Army, and the nation, The Catholic University of America is proud to bestow upon Brig. Gen. (Ret.) Bill Bester the degree Doctor of Nursing, *honoris causa*.

# Tyler J. VanderWeele

# Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa

How should we define human flourishing? The fullest and most persuasive answer will come from a range of disciplines, such as philosophy, theology, and economics. Tyler J. VanderWeele is an expert in all of these areas, and many others.

To his role as the John L. Loeb and Frances Lehman Loeb Professor of Epidemiology at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, where he directs Harvard's Human Flourishing Program, Dr. VanderWeele brings degrees in mathematics from Oxford University (twice), philosophy and theology (Oxford), finance and applied economics (University of Pennsylvania), and biostatistics (Harvard University). His research spans psychiatric, perinatal, and social epidemiology in looking to distinguish between association and causation in observational studies. His use of statistical and counterfactual ideas to formalize and advance epidemiologic theory and methods has been recognized with the 2017 President's Award from the Committee of Presidents of Statistical Societies — the "Nobel Prize" of statistics.

Dr. VanderWeele defines flourishing as "a state in which all aspects of a person's life are good." It has five domains: happiness and life satisfaction; mental and physical health; meaning and purpose; character and virtue; and close social relationships. Lately he has written of how the COVID-19 crisis, even with its suffering and hardship, can also be an occasion for gratitude, strengthening relationships, and reconciliation and forgiveness.

"When we deal with questions of human flourishing, we are talking both about what is the good life, which is a question of important philosophical and theological depth," VanderWeele says. "But we are also trying to consider how to bring it about. And that is often a question that some of the empirical sciences can help us address." While acknowledging that there are competing conceptions of "the good life," he maintains its pursuit should be an individual and societal goal, aided by businesses seeking to help their employees flourish, which will only enhance their business objectives.

His view has been formed through decades of research on the science of happiness, as well as religion and health, including both religion and population health and the role of religion and spirituality in end-of-life care. Dr. VanderWeele's findings appear in more than 300 peer-reviewed articles; he is also the author of *Explanation in Causal Inference: Methods for Mediation and Interaction*, hailed on its publication by Oxford University Press in 2015 as a landmark in its emerging field.

For his dazzling achievements across multiple disciplines to bring understanding and support to concepts of human flourishing, The Catholic University of America is pleased to bestow upon Tyler J. VanderWeele the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

#### **Robert Louis Wilken**

#### Doctor of History, honoris causa

In the year 600, then-Bishop of Rome Gregory the Great observed that the Word of God is a kind of river, "both shallow and deep, in which the lamb may find a footing and the elephant float at large." There may be no more knowledgeable guide to help today's lambs and elephants navigate the waters of the early Church than historian Robert Louis Wilken.

He is an expert on the Church fathers, the learned writers — including Gregory himself, as well as Augustine, Basil, Jerome, and many others — who articulated the Church's beliefs during the lengthy period between the writing of the New Testament and the Middle Ages. In those times, the aim was not seeking to invent a new world of ideas, Wilken shows us, but rather to win the hearts of men and women and to change their lives.

As professor emeritus at the University of Virginia, where he served as the William R. Kenan, Jr., Professor of the History of Christianity starting in 1985, Dr. Wilken continues his contributions to the field as a Distinguished Fellow at the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology and as chairman of the board of the Institute on Religion and Public Life, the publisher of *First Things*.

During his years as a teacher at Lutheran Theological Seminary, Fordham University, the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and the University of Notre Dame, in addition to the University of Virginia, Wilken wrote numerous popular, widely translated books. These include *The First Thousand Years: A Global History of Christianity; The Spirit of Early Christian Thought: Seeking the Face of God*; and *The Christians as the Romans Saw Them.* He emphasizes that religious liberty and freedom of conscience had their beginnings in religion, not politics, and he continues to express his conviction that justice is impossible in a society without religious freedom.

Raised in a devout Lutheran family and schooled at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis and University of Chicago, where his appreciation for Catholic liturgy blossomed into a desire to join the Catholic Church, Dr. Wilken's is a unique voice that brings the early Church to life for his students, readers, and fellow scholars.

In recognition of his distinguished contributions as a leading historian and for showing how early Christian writings remain an irreplaceable inheritance for all of us, The Catholic University of America is pleased to bestow upon Robert Louis Wilken the degree of Doctor of History, *honoris causa*.

# Doctor of Social Work, honoris causa

The lives of untold thousands of young people around the world are better because of the work of Kevin Ryan and the organization he leads as its CEO — Covenant House International. Now with operations in six countries and 31 U.S. cities, including just blocks from the University campus in Washington, D.C., it is the largest privately-funded agency in the Americas providing shelter, food, crisis care, and other vital services to homeless and runaway youth, who can feel especially isolated in the current atmosphere of restricted human contact.

In its half-century history, Covenant House — currently reaching some 74,000 youth every year — is credited with helping to transform and save more than a million lives. Its mission remains "to serve youth with absolute respect and unconditional love, to help kids who are suffering, and to protect and safeguard all children in need."

Although he is also a graduate of Georgetown Law Center and NYU Law School, Ryan is on record saying he learned his foundational lessons about serving and safeguarding vulnerable youth while at Catholic University. When accepting the Alumni Association's highest honor, the James Cardinal Gibbons Medal, in 2012, Ryan acknowledged the University as the place "where I met my wife, met the mentors and teachers of my life, and first learned of a special place for hurting kids called Covenant House."

For a decade in the 1990s, Ryan worked for Covenant House on the front lines with homeless and trafficked children in New York and New Jersey, before New Jersey's governor appointed him as the state's first child advocate. He later served as the first commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Children and Families. As commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Human Services, he drafted some of the state's most important laws for youth. He was appointed chief of staff to the U.N. special envoy for malaria in 2008, charged with marshalling public and private resources to tackle a disease then killing nearly one million children a year.

Under his leadership since 2009, Covenant House's international Sleep Out movement has engaged thousands in raising awareness and funds to support the homeless. Its other efforts to save at-risk youth from the streets have been recognized with the Olaf Palme Peace Prize, the U.S. Department of State Hero Citation, and the Conrad Hilton Humanitarian Award. In 2010, the Vatican Mission to the United Nations presented Ryan with its Path to Peace Award.

For embodying the ideals of Catholic University throughout a life dedicated to the protection of desperate and abandoned children, The Catholic University of America is pleased to bestow upon Kevin Ryan the degree of Doctor of Social Work, *honoris causa*.

# **Academic Costume**

The history of academic dress reaches back to the 13th century. Academic gowns were prescribed to avoid excess in apparel, although it is believed that gowns were also worn for warmth. Whether the origin of academic dress is ecclesiastical or civilian has never been settled.

The code of academic dress in the United States was adopted in 1895. The gown commonly worn for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves (with a slit for the arm). It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve, open at the wrist.

The gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped open sleeves. All gowns are black with no trimming, except the doctoral, which is trimmed with velvet. The master's and doctoral gowns are so designed that they may be worn open or closed.

Hoods are three feet long for the bachelor's, three and one-half feet for the master's, and four feet for the doctoral degrees. The hood is lined with colors of the institution — gold and white for The Catholic University of America — and is trimmed with the color associated with the academic field of specialization, as follows:

Architecture - Blue Violet Arts, Letters, and Humanities - White Business - Drab Canon Law - Scarlet Economics - Copper Education - Light Blue Engineering – Orange Fine Arts - Brown Law - Purple Library Science - Lemon Yellow Music - Pink Nursing - Apricot Philosophy – Dark Blue Science - Golden Yellow Social Work - Citron Theology - Scarlet
